Presidents Message

2019 has been another very busy year. We have completed all of the access improvements at Deka, Higgins and Sulphurous Lakes. The project has taken several years but as you can all see, the rewards have been worth it.

In addition, we have been part of a team that is working on the Womack Road Emergency Access as well as the wildfire fuel break. Will be able to give you a further update later in the spring.

The Hathaway Access project is close to being completed with hopes that all the work will be done by next summer. A parking lot has been put in to keep the vehicles off the road and users safe and a launch will be accessible for your small fishing boats just a few hundred feet down from the parking lot. This project is in partnership with Fisheries and Recreation and Trails, but it will be the users and community responsibility to keep it cared for, the same as every other access within our area. A special thank you to the Furbers for their work on this project to date.

We will be concentrating on cleaning up the Advertising and Community board at Mahood and Horse Lake Road. If you know of anyone interested in advertising, please have them contact us directly. The cost is very inexpensive and the benefits are great.

The Deka Lake and District Fire Department donated all of their older picnic tables to our Association when they replaced them with new fold up tables. A special thank you to Chris Schmidt and other volunteers for taking the lead on scraping, repairing and re-staining all of them throughout the summer.

We replaced 2 of our porta potties on Deka Access 7 and 12, adding additional picnic tables at several accesses. To reference all of the picnic areas and

Sulphurous Lake , access 3 located on Pettyjohn just down from Mahood is being dedicated for kayaks and canoes. Signage is now up for the users directing those who have power boats to the launch further up the road.

Solar lights have been added to the Sulphurous Bulletin Board as well as Blain and Burgess at Deka. The solar light over on Beazely 1 has shown to be quite successful during the night.

Some of the floor in the swimming areas are still a bit mucky and need time to settle and harden. Usage of all swimming areas will speed up the process. Please note that the access roundabouts and driveways must remain clear of parking including your Off Road Vehicles. Please park in the designated parking spots. The accesses and recreation sites are looked after entirely by volunteers so take pride in the area, drive slowly and take a moment to remove your garbage. Let your friends and family who come to visit know the rules of the road and what they can do to help out.

As always I continue to be inspired by those residents who have volunteered in cleaning up our access's and those who have volunteered to adopt an access, cutting the lawn, keeping it clean and letting us know if additional work is needed. As our community grows we will need more community support. Our community depends on working together, taking care of what we have, cleaning up after ourselves and taking an extra minute to pull some branches or move a few rocks on the lakeshore. Egress and Fire Mitigation update

In terms of the egress route, the biologist confirmed there was no fish in the creek so we had a large culvert installed in that crossing as well as at least 6 other culverts Womack Rd. We also completed ditching and brushing. We will have to wait until spring to complete the gravelling on the road. As for the fuel breaks, hand crews are currently working on the south and east sides of the community and then will be moving on to the Higgins portion. The harvesting contracts are just being advertised with an expectancy of a March 31 finish. Because of the lateness and snow depth, we will have to issue another contract in the spring, once it's snow free, for an excavator to do the fine clean up, to get the stuff that is buried under the snow that the contractors can't see.

NEW FIRETRUCK

This is the year Deka Lake and Distrct volunteer fire fighters get their new truck. Engine 11 has finally expired and needs to be replaced to meet Canadian certification. This is important for our home owner insurance discounts. The fact that our trucks maintain certification and our volunteer firefighters are professionally trained is recognized by insurance under writers.

Even though the trucks don't have a lot of miles on them, they are still subject to wear and tear. Constant weight on the suspension, driving on our roads and old equipment all contribute. When trucks get called out, they leave before the engines are fully warmed up. This is very hard on diesel engines.

The new truck will cost \$ 450,000 and a decision must be reached on how to pay for it. I'm only a layman, but here's my interpretation from government speak.

We have a choice of paying for it over 5 years or

ten years. If it's paid for over 5 years our taxes will go up 20% in the first year and inflationary amounts years 2 – 5. Over 10 years our taxes will only go up by the inflationary amount for years 1 – 5. The CRD considers the 10 year plan a better deal
